brings African voices for liberty to the world. The program syndicates English-language articles in the African press, and produces audio and video content. Its scholars are frequent commentators in the African

broadcast and print media. *AfricanLiberty.org* publishes classical liberal texts in Africa, and co-sponsors summer seminars with the Ghanaian think tank IMANI.

promotes civil society, free enterprise and limited government to the Russian-speaking world. In

addition to offering online studies, texts, libraries, and podcasts, the program syndicates to the Russian media, runs an annual Russian-language summer school to develop networks of young libertarian leaders, sponsors student essay contests, and hosts a series of lectures at Moscow's top universities.

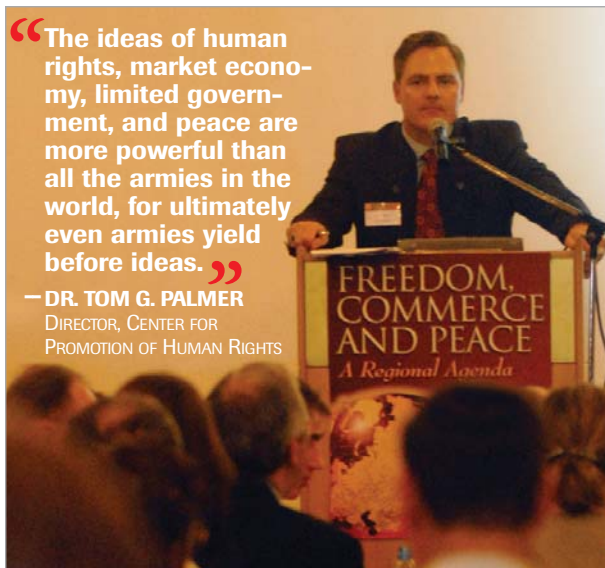


TIANDAOCN.ORG

CATO IN EUROPE

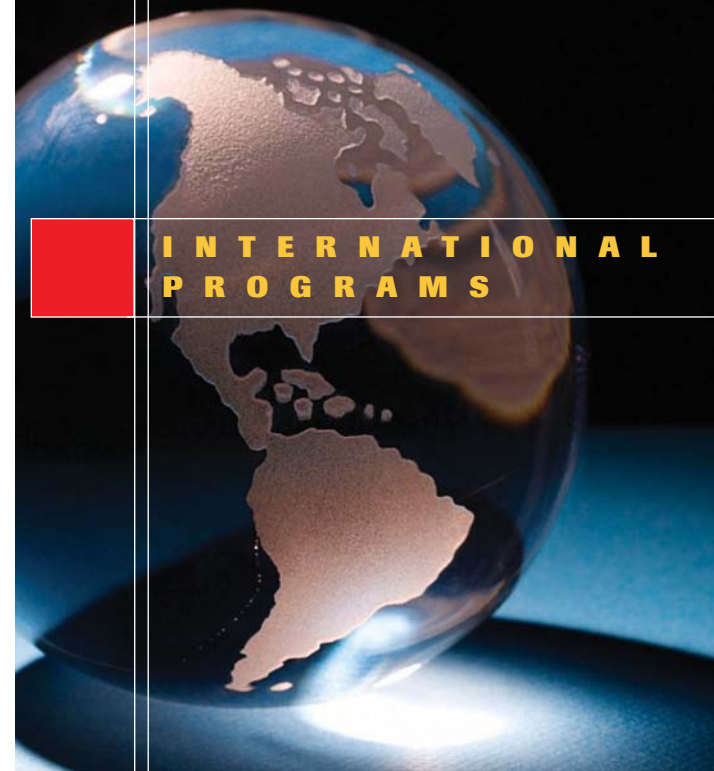

MISBAHALHURRIYYA.ORG

syndicates articles to newspapers throughout the Arab-speaking world, and publishes libertarian texts such as Hayek's *The Road to Serfdom* and Mill's *On Liberty* in Arabic. Projects include the web-based "Interactive World Map of Economic Freedom" and a series of cartoons, to be broadcast on Arab television, promoting the free society. *Misbah Al Hurriyya* has won awards for its presence in the Arabic internet. Conferences for students and policy makers are planned.



CHIRIAZADI.ORG

brings classical liberal ideas through print, internet, and multimedia to Kurdish-speakers worldwide. *Chiriazadi.org* has published Bastiat's *The Law*, which is used as a text at Kurdish universities. Further translations, including John Stuart Mill's *On Liberty*, are planned for 2008.

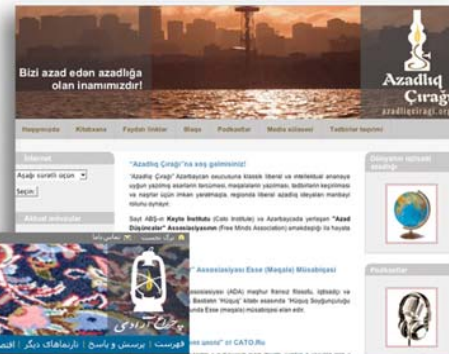
